
From Fr. Greg Havel...

BREAKING OPEN THE WORD- You might be wondering what happens with all those young children when they leave Mass and head for the basement on Sunday mornings. If you were a mouse in the corner, this is what you would see.

We gather on the stage, sitting on a big round rug. The goal is to open God's Word, to look at the readings through the eyes of a child and break it into pieces that they will understand.

We use American Sign Language with the Psalm Response. Whenever we can sign with our hands, we involve more senses, and we have a better chance of understanding. One of the goals is fuller and more active participation. Signing helps accomplish this.

The helpers wear many hats. They are the musicians. Some songs we know by heart. Newer ones, we are accompanied by choir chimes. Our helpers read from the Children's Lectionary. We talk about what a Lector does and what an ambo is. The gospel is read and acted out, using props or costumes when possible. John the Baptist holds his box of locusts and honey, the disciples sat in a paper boat, a dove made of coffee filters came down from heaven resting on each child as they took turns being Jesus at his Baptism. Everyone held a flashlight or battery operated candle for the light of the world. Anything that will leave an imprint on the young minds is utilized.

The children listen and participate. It is a blessing to see the older ones helping the younger ones. We practice making the sign of the cross, also signing ourselves before the gospel. We talk about hearing God's word and how we believe the Bible. We hear over and over how God's love has no beginning and no end. God's word is never wasted. When these young children hear it I believe they take it to heart. That is my prayer for them. Lea Nowak
