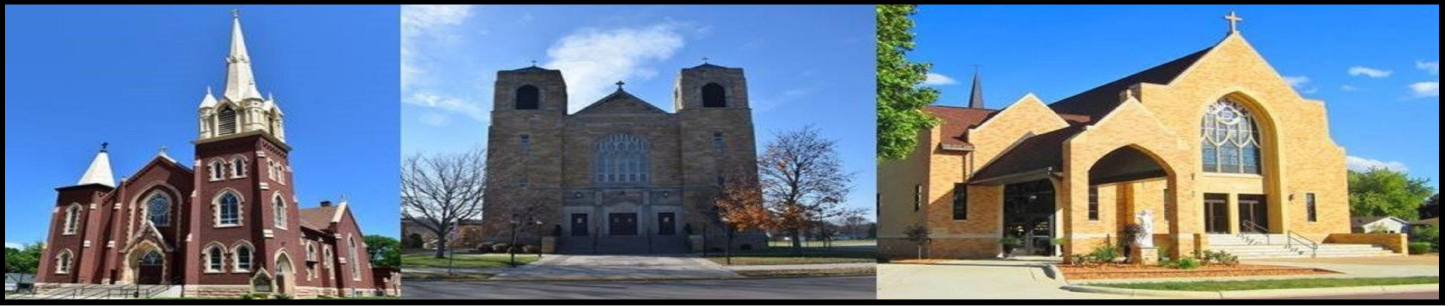

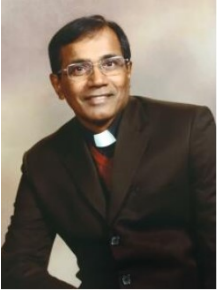

PRAYER & WORSHIP



Feast of Corpus Christi (Week 9th in Ordinary Time), June 2, 2024-B Cycle

Readings: Exodus 24:3-8; Hebrews 9:11-15; Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

Today we are celebrating the Feast of the Holy Eucharist or the Body and Blood of Christ. Eucharist in the Church is understood as a communal sacrificial meal, offered by the community of believers along with the priest, to the Heavenly Father together with Jesus for the remission of sins and as an offering of gratitude and thanksgiving.

In the Old Covenant, bread and wine were offered in a thanksgiving sacrifice as a sign of grateful acknowledgement to the Creator as the giver and sustainer of life. Melchizedek, who was both a priest and king (Genesis 14:18; Hebrew 7:1-4) offered a sacrifice of bread and wine. His offering prefigured the offering made by Jesus, our high priest and king. The remembrance of the manna in the wilderness indicates that the people of Israel live not by earthly bread alone but by the bread of the Word of God (Deuteronomy 8:3).

Every sacrifice involves an offering. Here in the Eucharist, Jesus offers Himself and His life out of love for us His friends. He completes this offering on the Cross as He offers Himself totally to the Father. This offering is a gift, and every gift involves the giver and the receiver. It is a sacrifice to the giver and gift to the receiver. Jesus here uses the symbol of a MEAL to make us realize His presence.

Every meal has its social dimension. Each celebration of ours, religious or secular, ends with a meal. A meal unites people, holds the family together and builds a community. Jesus uses this simple celebration of a meal to give us His closeness to us. It is built on the idea of a family, where everyone shares the common food, and all are equal.

Come and eat the Body. Come and drink the Blood. Enter the mystery, the deep mystery of God who loves us so much. Give thanks for the Gift of this New Covenant. ~ Fr. Pratap

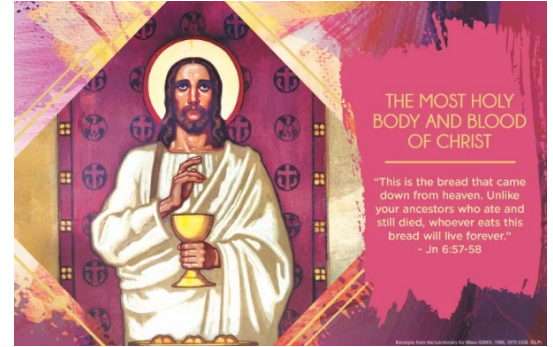
BAPTISM PREPARATION: Contact the parish office a month in advance to fill out the form and to attend Baptism Mentoring Sessions.

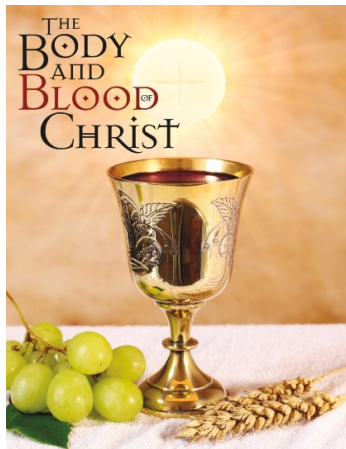
There will not be Adoration on June 8th in Minnesota Lake due to Deacon Brian Klein's Ordination in Winona.
