In the beautiful Gospel story of Martha and Mary, we learn about life and faith. Mary, when Jesus came to their home, chose to sit at the feet of Jesus and listen to his words. She says, "Lord do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me." May we never allow differences to divide us in a common faith in the Lord. There are, by way of example, lots of roads that get to Mankato.
