A Word from Fr. Havel...

Dear Parishioners of the Tri-Parish,

Monday's funeral for Elaine Wanzek will be the fourth funeral liturgy I have had the privilege of celebrating since my arrival. Thank you to everyone for your service to the families of those who have died. Please remember those who have died and the grieving in your prayers.

During a funeral liturgy, weddings, etc., when there are a larger portion of guests (Catholic and non–Catholic) present, I will try to give directions of when to stand, kneel, or to be seated. I do this to help people be together in this time of prayer with peaceful hearts and to not have to wonder what we should do at a particular time. For example, after the Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy) I invite people to kneel or be seated as they wish. Catholics should kneel for the Eucharistic Prayer. Non-Catholics often do not kneel in their different denominations and so I want to let them know that it is okay for them to be seated. I am clarifying this so that everyone gathered in these holy times of prayer can feel welcome and at peace; open to the grace of our God.
