

A Word from Fr. Havel...

The word of God comes to us today in the voice of Isaiah the prophet when he speaks about the long awaited Messiah. Isaiah says, "Then will the eyes of the blind be opened, the ears of the deaf be cleared; then will the lame leap like a stag, then the tongue of the mute will sing." We are told these things are signs of the coming of the savior.

John the Baptist sends two disciples to ask Jesus, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" Instead of responding with a simple yes or no answer, Jesus says, "Go and tell John what you see and hear: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them."

Jesus shows himself to be the fulfillment of the prophetic message. He invites the disciples of John to give witness to what they have experienced. We too are called to give witness to our faith, that Jesus is the savior of all peoples, by sharing the stories of our lives and how God has been present to us. May we always give witness to God by sharing what we have seen and heard in our lives.
