



St. Casimir's Classroom News

We have been so busy in the kindergarten and first grade classroom at St. Casimir's School! In Language Arts the students are learning about singular and plural nouns and that they name a person, place, animal, or thing. Our students are also busy learning the sounds of letters so they can decode new words and memorizing sight words! It's exciting to be teaching the first graders again this year, as I get to see how much they have grown academically since last March! They are doing quite well with reading decodable stories and stories with sight words. Kindergarteners are doing a fine job of memorizing their sight words and learning to decode consonant-vowel-consonant (CVC) words.

Math has been a bit of review for both grades which is quite helpful after the spring we had last year with distance learning. First grade is reviewing addition and subtraction while kindergarten is reviewing patterns and what makes a pattern. Kindergarten has moved on to counting and 1 to 1 correspondence with numbers from 1 to 10.

We have had a great start to the year and look forward to being able to continue to learn in person.
