Sanctuary Light: The candle, most often in a red glass holder, that burns by the Tabernacle in a Catholic Church is a reminder to us as we enter, that Jesus, in the Blessed Sacrament, is present. When the Blessed Sacrament is removed from the Church, (Good Friday or other special times of need) the candle is extinguished until the Blessed Sacrament is returned. If you are visiting a Catholic Church which is not familiar to you look for the candle and you will know where to genuflect as the Body of Christ will be very near.
