Jesus sends out His disciples with instructions on how to live as they proclaim the message of God's love for all people. He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave. Whatever place does not welcome you, leave there and shake the dust from your feet in testimony against them." Jesus does not call us to join in religious arguments with people but rather to proclaim the message.

It almost seems like a repeat of last weeks Scripture Reading as God sends Ezekiel the prophet to a rebellious people of Israel saying, "Hard of face and obstinate of heart are they to whom I am sending you. But you shall say to them; Thus says the Lord God! And whether they heed or resist for they are a rebellious house- they shall know that a prophet has been among them."

Be faithful to the Gospel. Proclaim the Good News of Jesus. This is the work God has entrusted to us!
