

PRAYER & WORSHIP

Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, December 28, 2025-A Cycle

Readings: Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14; Psalm 128:1-5; Colossians 3:12-21; Mt 2:13-15, 19-23

Dear Brothers and Sisters of our Tri-Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the **Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph**, a beautiful reminder that God chose to enter our world not through power or spectacle, but through the quiet strength and love of a family life.

On this Sunday, we reflect on the holiness that can be found in our own homes built on faithfulness, patience, and mutual care.

This is the time to reflect the dignity and sacredness of the family unit. The family is the “domestic Church.” It is a place where faith is taught, virtue is formed, and love is learned.

Today, families come in many shapes and circumstances. Yet every family, whatever its composition, is called to be a school of love, protection, and forgiveness. Like a mother bird shielding her young, the family must be a refuge that nurtures life until it is ready to soar.

The Holy Family of Nazareth offers us a path. To live like them is to live in simplicity, fidelity, and joy. It is to support, protect, and serve one another and to love without counting the cost.

If we let their example shape our homes, if fathers love like St. Joseph, if mothers nurture like Mary, if children grow in obedience and grace like Jesus, then our own families become holy ground. They become small Nazareths, hidden yet radiant with divine love.

Can we imagine what the world would be like if every home reflected even a fraction of the holiness of Nazareth? A world where every family is a place of prayer, forgiveness, and faith, a world where love is learned first at the dinner table and carried into the public square.

In the book of Sirach, we are reminded that honoring one another within the family reflects our relationship with God.

As we approach the New Year 2026, let us ask the Holy Family to intercede for all our households:

- For unity where there is division,
- Healing where there is hurt,
- Strength where there is fatigue,
- And renewed faith where hope feels dim.

May our homes become places where Christ is welcomed, love is practiced, and peace is nurtured!
